Building Connections (School Teams)

This presentation is tailored for **school teams** (resource teachers, classroom teachers, educational assistants, clinicians) working with children diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). It highlights understanding ASD from a developmental and core deficits perspective; and provides a relationship-based framework for increasing dynamic thinking and engagement.

In this workshop, **school teams**:

- learn how to use *relationships* meaningfully to guide acquisition skills required to learn, socialize, and function in daily activities
- learn how to consider *sensory preferences* when enabling participation in everyday occupations
- learn how to *scaffold* engagement and activities to encourage exploration and interactions
- build a “*toolbox*” of skills and strategies to guide children in their exploration of the world, and enable the child’s ability to self-regulate, think, learn, and problem solve
